In the last newsletter, we wrote about feeding poor widows. One widow lived with her daughter, son-in-law, and grandchildren in the "slums." Both parents worked full-time as unskilled laborers, but still could not afford decent housing. The widow's daughter enrolled in one of our evening English-language classes and was soon proficient enough to get a well-paying job in the tourism industry. The family is now living in a safe community in a house with electricity and water.

They thank God for the opportunity to make a better future for their family. **We thank you for making it possible for us to have a hand in transforming this family's lives.**



Families in Crisis

Many families are plunged into poverty when a husband dies or abandons the wife. Recently, we ministered to such a family who are new to the area. Despite working two jobs and running a home business, a medical expense put the family in financial crisis. To ease the strain, we provided enough food for a couple of weeks to allow the family to get back on their feet. The mother, who has a Catholic background, wanted to know why we, as foreigners and non-Catholics, would be so willing to help. She has been attending our Bible studies to learn more about the source of the love that we have for the people of Mexico.
