A Funny Thing Happened on Our Way To...

In Christian service, we often set out to do one thing and God directs us into another. When we decided to move to Mexico our plan was to minister exclusively to Mexicans. In Puerto Morelos, we found that there was no Bible-centered congregation for English-speakers so we began attending a Mexican church. Soon, we met other believers who were also wanting solid Bible teaching in English. We began as 5 and grew to 20 within months. As we continued to minister to impoverished Mexican families, we began to have Mexicans come to our Bible Fellowship, including a bilingual lady who graciously offered to translate. Now, our bilingual church has outgrown our home. Our vision is for a building that houses a bilingual church, a clinic, a after-school Bible program, and classes to teach vocational skills.
